# Book Title - Go Away, Big Green Monster!

Before Reading		
Core Word Focus - highlight in book	Away, go, not, stop / again, big	
Fringe Word Focus Book Song	Body parts and colors Tune: "Five Little Monkeys"	
Print Concept Focus	Reading print from left to right	
Letter-Sound Activities Letter Song	p Tune: "The Farmer in the Dell"	
Picture Walk Through	Flip through the book & "read" pictures to introduce students to the vocabulary and help make connections to background knowledge. As you point out the pictures, emphasize the use of core words. <u>Examples</u> : "This is a BIG monster!", "WHAT DO YOU SEE?", "This is MY favorite part!", "He is NOT scary!", "I LIKE his purple hair!"	

During R	eading
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Put the CROWD in the CAR	<u>Completion</u> - Tell the monster to (go away)! Pg.23
<u>C</u> omment - <u>A</u> sk - <u>R</u> espond	<u><b>R</b>ecall</u> - What other body parts did we talk about in the story? Pg.25
with CROWD Questions	Open Ended - I wonder what you think is scary about the monster? Pg.11
CROWD Questions	Wh Question - Point to the body parts and ask: What is this? Where is your nose/mouth/eyes? Pg.5
	<b>D</b> istancing - We told the monster to go away. Who else do you tell to go away? Pg.29
Story Props and Toys	Pictures velcroed on craft sticks. Students can use the story props to participate during the story.
