Before Reading

Core Word Focus - highlight in book	Boy, eat, girl, happy, sad / friend, give, ready
Fringe Word Focus Book Song	Emotions, teacher, mom, lunch, seat Tune: "Have You Ever Seen a Lassie?"
Print Concept Focus	Letter vs. word
Letter-Sound Activities Letter Song	c Tune: "The Farmer in the Dell"
Picture Walk Through	Flip through the book & "read" pictures to introduce students to the vocabulary and help make connections to background knowledge. As you point out the pictures, emphasize the use of core words. Examples: "WHAT DO YOU SEE?", "IT is time to EAT lunch.", "This BOY is HAPPY because he LIKES chicken.", "Sam is READY to EAT."

During Reading

Put the CROWD in the CAR	Completion - Max (gives) him chicken, rice and peas. Pg.28
<u>C</u> omment - <u>A</u> sk - <u>R</u> espond	Recall - Dan has ham. What other foods did the students bring? Pg.12

	Distancing - How would you feel if you didn't have a lunch? Pg.20
Story Props and Toys	Pictures velcroed on craft sticks. Students can use the story props to participate during the story.
