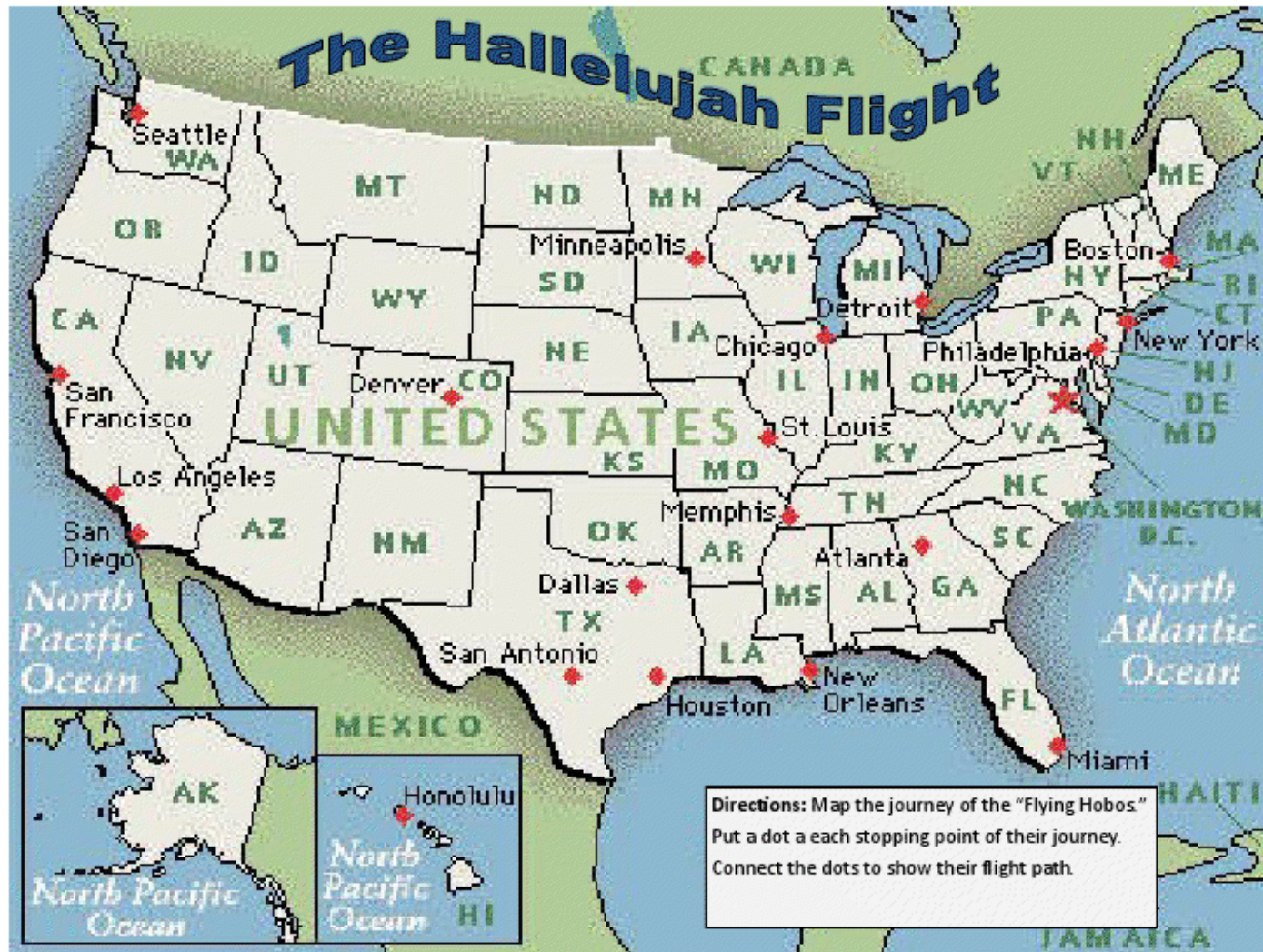

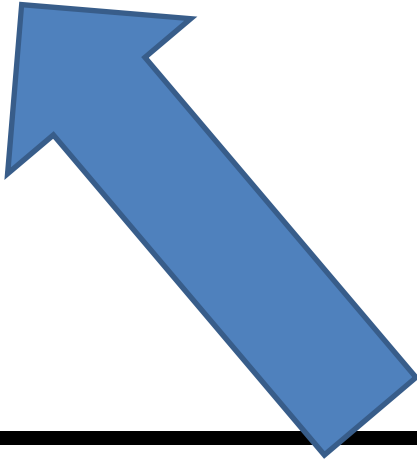
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# PrAACtical Language Opportunities

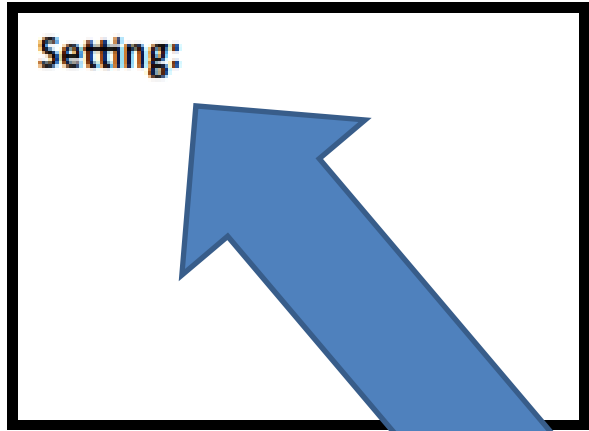
Characters:

- He was a pilot. He lived in the Depression. He was a hero.

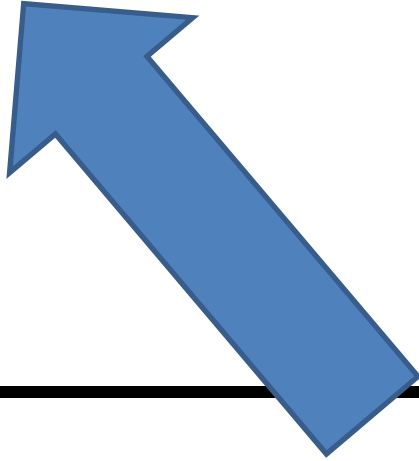




“Tell us something about the setting”

- Sky, field, day
- Mountains, towns, cities.
- Went different places. Many fields. Small towns. Big city at the end.
- Started in the west and ended in the east.

Problem:



“Tell us about the problems in this story.”

- Old plane. No money. Bad weather. Mean people
- His plane was broken. He had no money to fix it. Some people were mean to him.
- They flew in bad weather. They almost crashed.
