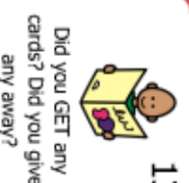
PLAY dress up! PUT something funny ON. Do you LIKE it?

Play a 'stop and GO' game.



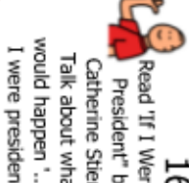
Did you GET any cards? Did you give any away?

Build in some communication temptations! Use a wind up toy or activity that is motivating.



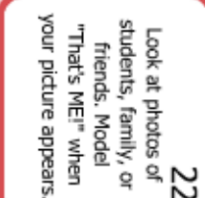
Model "AGAIN" to request more of an activity.

Two words: photo booth!



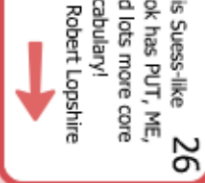

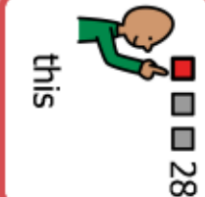
