Can you catch a firefly? They fly HIGH, THEN let it go!

Find a picture of your GRANDFATHER

Today is national Ice Cream Day! MAYBE you can go out for ice cream. Will you SHARE?

Sometimes we have choices but we need to pick just ONE. Talk about picking ONE thing today. Just ONE.

Building with blocks lets you use lots of core words!

Phrases with Core On the BOTTOM. It is HIGH. MAYBE it will fall. REALLY HIGH ONE. SHARE, please.

Brush the BOTTOM teeth. You missed ONE!

Practice using 30 more general words like 'SOMETHING.' You can point or describe, but not every word must be there. Use your core!

Sometimes our plans change based on the WEATHER. Use MAYBE to talk about an activity.
