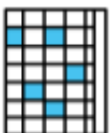

2 Ask "Do you like my HAIR?"



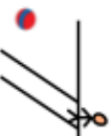

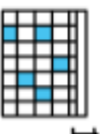
16 See if you can sit in the MIDDLE today.
