Look for times to say **SORRY**. Apologizing is an important social skill.

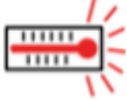


Sort some old toys and books to **GIVE** to **OTHERS**.

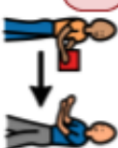


Tuesday

**GIVE** me a turn! Don't **GIVE** up. **GIVE** him one.



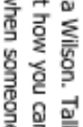
Award winning book, Draw **Together**, features a boy and his grandpa as they find a way to communicate.
