

Lesson Planning Form

Book Title - What Do You Like?

Before Reading

Core Word Focus - highlight in book	Review previous words / like, do, you, want
Fringe Word Focus Book Song	Rainbow, cat, fruit, music, fly, mother, jump rope, boomerang, cat, tiger, apple, watermelon, piano, flute, balloon, airplane Tune: "London Bridge"
Print Concept Focus	Turning the pages
Letter-Sound Activities Letter Song	t Tune: "The Farmer in the Dell"
Picture Walk Through	Flip through the book & "read" pictures to introduce students to the vocabulary and help make connections to background knowledge. As you point out the pictures, emphasize the use of core words. <u>Example questions:</u> "WHAT DO YOU SEE? IT is a beautiful rainbow!", "I LIKE fruit. DO YOU LIKE fruit?", "We SEE cows on a farm."

During Reading

Put the CROWD in the CAR Comment - Ask - Respond with CROWD Questions	Completion - I like _____ (music, too). Pg.20 Recall - What are some other things the child likes? Pg.18 Open Ended - I wonder what things you like? What do you love? Pg.28 Wh Question - What kind of a cat is this? Pg.12 Distancing - Here is a rainbow. When do you see a rainbow? Pg. 4
Story Props and Toys	Pictures velcroed on craft sticks. Students can use the story props to participate during the story.
