Book Title - Max's Breakfast

Before Reading

Core Word Focus - highlight in book	All gone, down, get, on, where / different, there
Fringe Word Focus Book Song	Breakfast, egg, strawberry, Max, Ruby, hid, napkin, chair, table Tune: "Here We Go Round the Mulberry Bush"
Print Concept Focus	Pictures vs. words; review all concepts
Letter-Sound Activities Letter Song	u Tune: "The Farmer in the Dell"
Picture Walk Through	Flip through the book & "read" pictures to introduce students to the vocabulary and help make connections to background knowledge. As you point out the pictures, emphasize the use of core words. <u>Examples:</u> "Max and Ruby are wearing <i>DIFFERENT</i> clothes.", "Ruby will <i>GET</i> the egg.", "THAT would make me <i>FEEL SAD</i> , too."

During Reading

Put the CROWD in the CAR <u>C</u> omment - <u>A</u> sk - <u>R</u> espond with CROWD Questions	C ompletion - Max doesn't like his egg, he says _____ (bad egg). Pg.8 R ecall - Where did Max hide his egg? Pg.4 O pen Ended - Max doesn't like the egg. I wonder what he will do? Pg.2 W h Question - What does Max not like to eat? Pg.5 D istancing - What food don't you like? What food do you like to eat? Pg.10
