Green: Verbs

Yellow: Pronouns

Orange: Nouns

White: Conjunctions

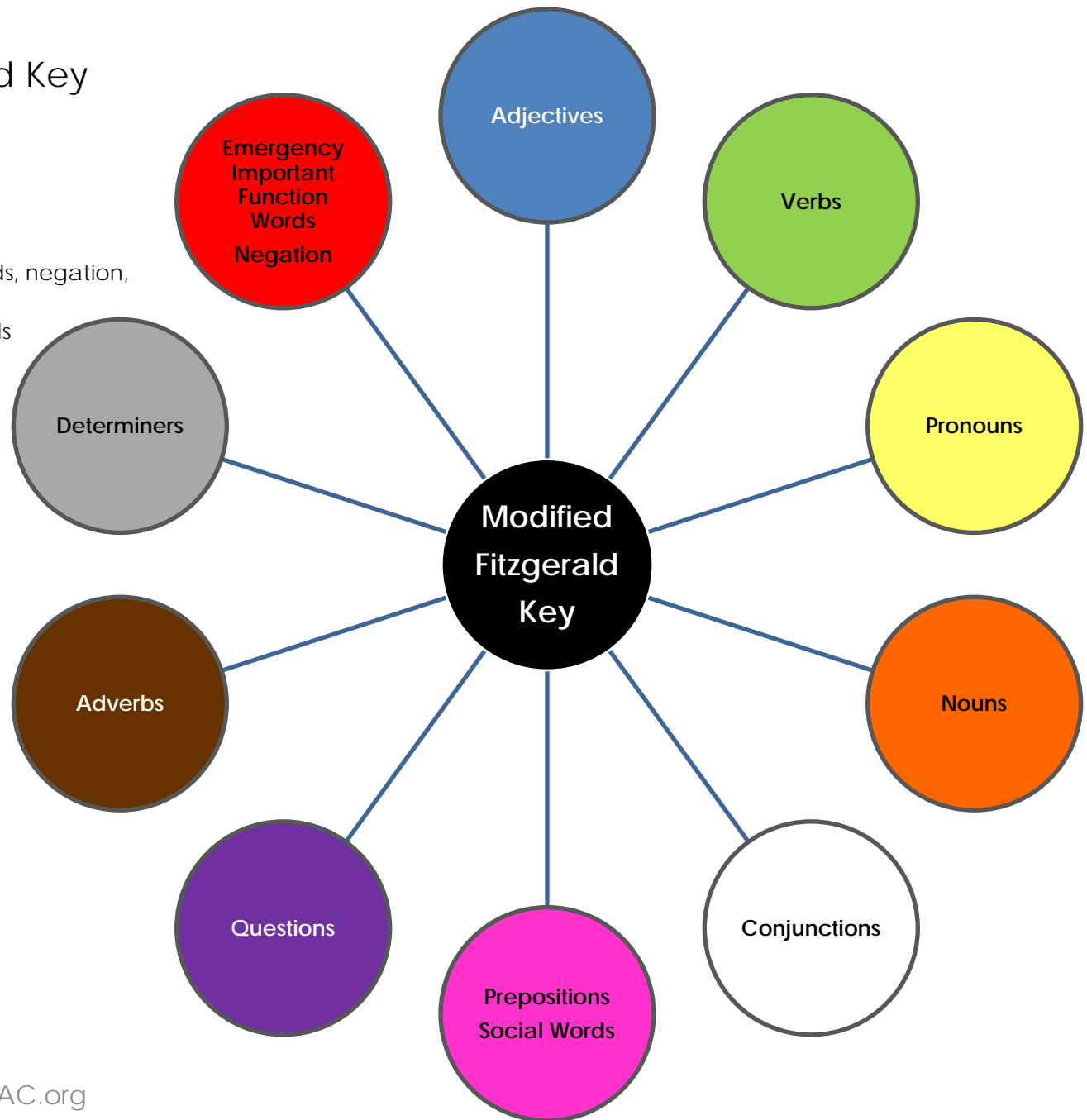
Red: Important function words, negation, emergency words

Pink: Prepositions, social words

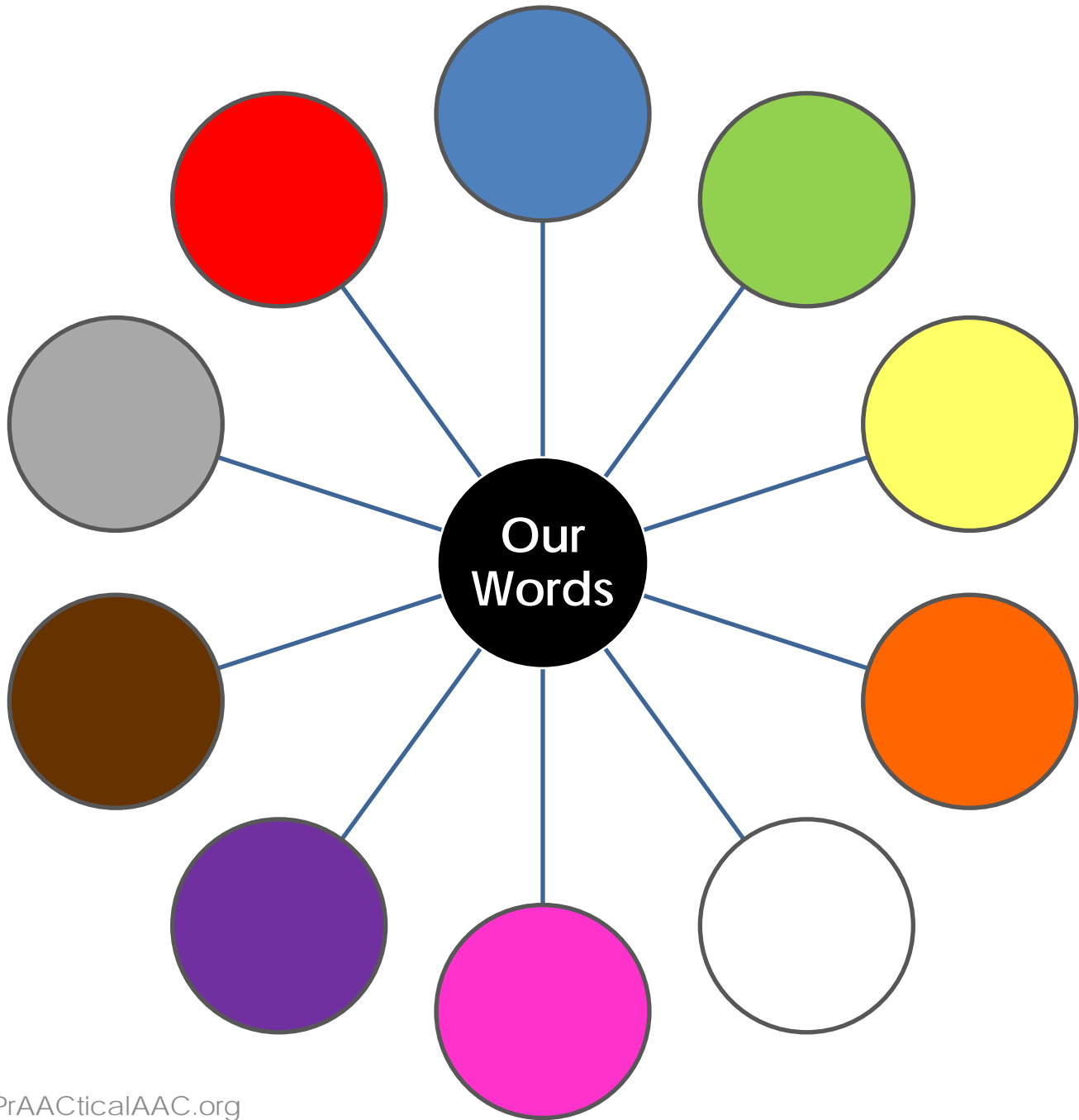
Purple: Questions

Brown: Adverbs

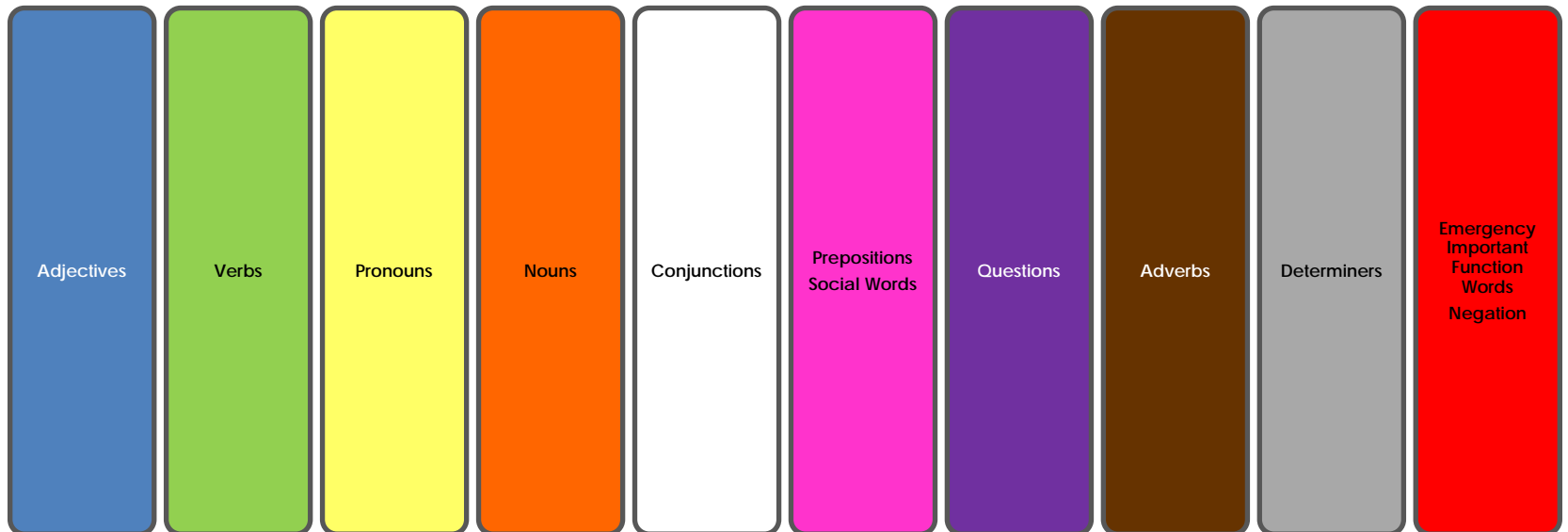
Grey: Determiners

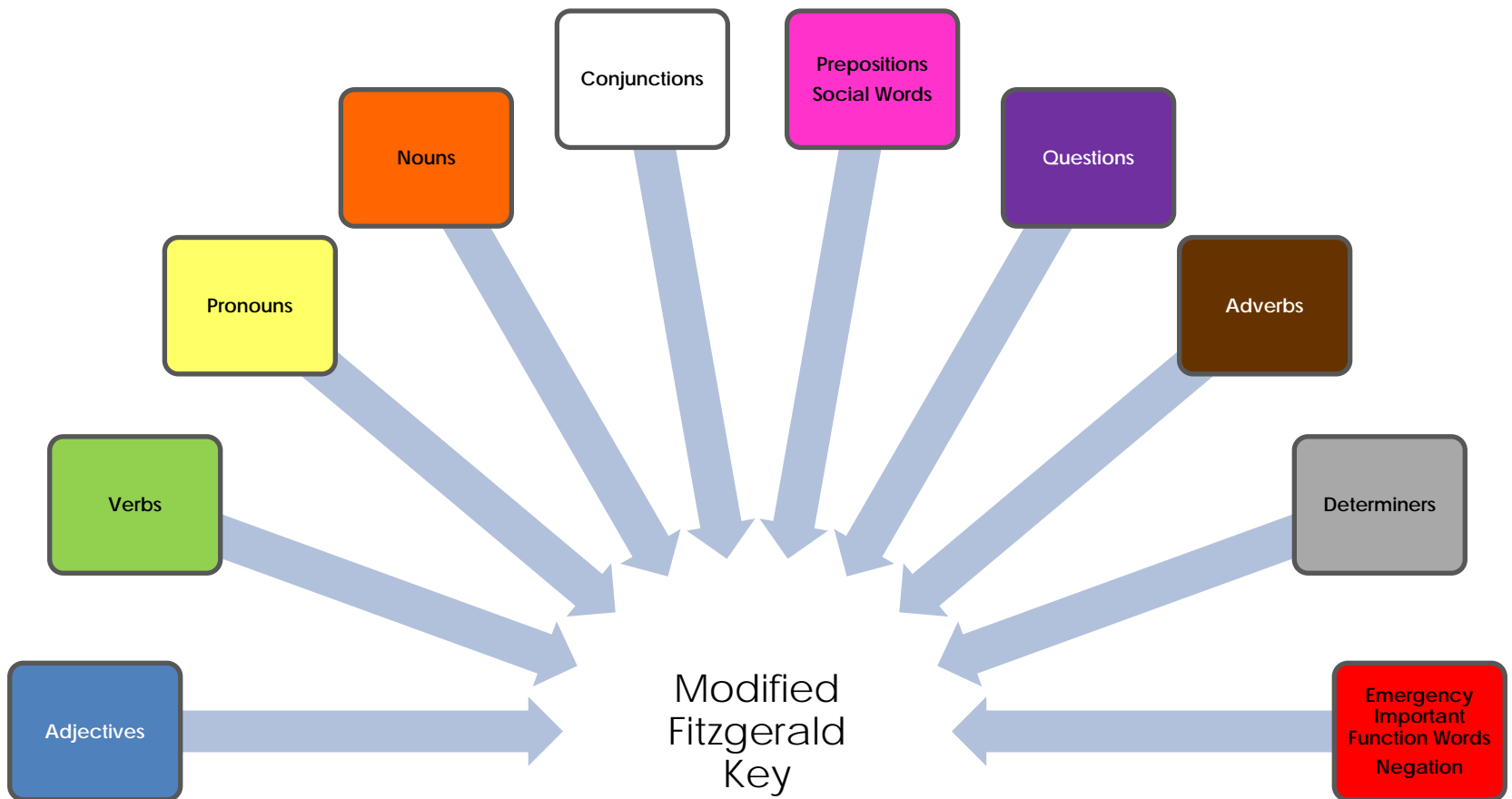


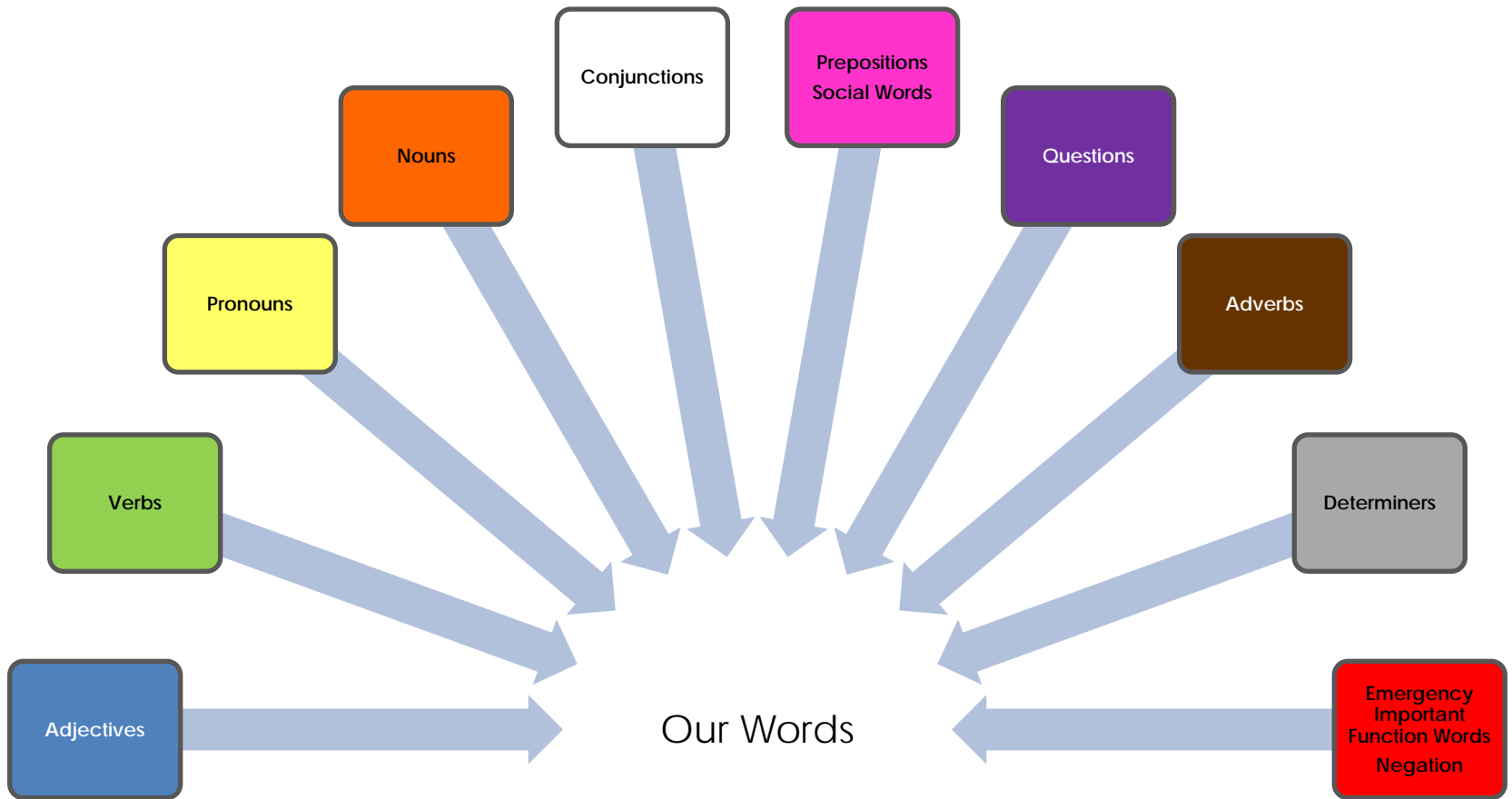




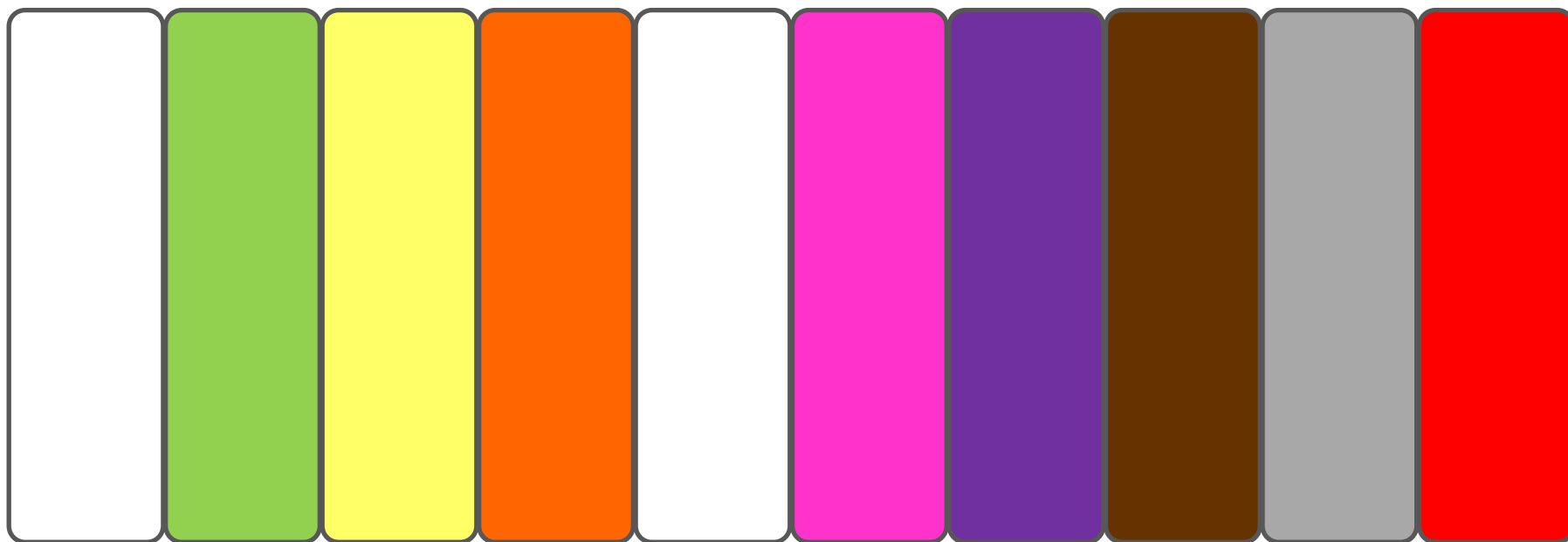
