CALL someone on the phone and tell them something NICE.



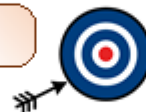

Ask someone new, "What is your NAME?"



Go on a listening scavenger hunt. Find animal noises, voices, vehicles.



LISTEN to music. Talk about whether you like it or not.



Look through a magazine to find the letters in your NAME.



Use TAKE in phrases: Take a break. Take your time. Take a bath. Take out the trash.



WRITE a list of your five favorite things.



Talk about transitions. It's ALMOST TIME to go.



Find four things you can SIT on. For example: chair, bench, bean bag, swing.



A Squiggly Story is fantastic for emergent writers. By Andrew Larsen, this story is about attributing meaning to early writing.



Find two things that show what TIME it is.
